Entry Requirements

UNITED KINGDOM - There are currently no requirements for Australian Citizens to hold a visa to enter the UK.

FRANCE (Europe) - Your passport must be valid for at least six months at the time of your entry



Students travelling without their parents are required to complete the following form which assigns temporary guardianship for the duration of the tour. This means we can be with students if they are held at customs or in a medical emergency.

Luggage on Tour

Strict Luggage Dimensions apply to each person on this tour due to the storage limitations of the motor-coach. Please ensure that you source one large sized check-in bag and a regular carry-on backpack according to the image below.

The carry-on bag should be a backpack that will be used throughout the tour on day trips. For students, this should be your team backpack. For chaperones, this should be a regular bag (not a roller bag).

At the hotels, tour members are expected to take their own luggage to their rooms.



You will receive your official Travel Gang luggage tag when you arrive at the airport. This should be secured to the **TOP** of your suitcase so we can easily identify all luggage belonging to the group. Simply fold the tag into it's own loop (do not tie a knot as it will come undone).









In-Flight

It is a good idea to bring a ziplock bag for the plane, which has these items in it. Keep this bag in the seat pocket in front of you so you don't need to keep getting up and down during the flight. You should also use this bag to ensure your phone, passport and boarding pass don't get left behind (keep everything in this bag).

Each morning at breakfast, we provide essential communication. These are mandatory so please be on time even if you don't want to eat breakfast.

- A small amount of UK cash (eg. \$200)
- Travel cards or debit card (don't forget to notify your bank that you are travelling via their app).

CARRY ON

- Passport
- Pen (to complete necessary forms)
- Lollies for the plane to help ear equalisation
- You may decide to buy 'ear planes' which reduce discomfort during take-off.
- Any medications (eg Asthma inhaler)
- Printed medical plan
- Neck pillow (small)
- One change of clothes and a jumper.

TOILETRIES (Travel Size)

- Toiletry bag
- Toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant
- Hair/ skin care products
- Handkerchiefs/tissues
- Lip balm
- TravaCalm/ medications/ Panadol



SEATING

Travel Gang have requested families be seated together on the plane. The seating is allocated by the airline. They usually give us a large block of seats at the back of the aircraft.

Travel Insurance

You are required to source your own Travel Insurance Policy and notify us of your insurance policy details so that we can assist if medical treatment is required. There are many companies that offer travel insurance. You should make sure your travel insurance covers all medical expenses for injury or illness (including COVID), as well as theft of valuables, damage to baggage and cancellations or interruptions to flight plans. Accidents can happen to anyone, and medical costs overseas can reach hundreds of thousands of dollars. Australian citizens have faced financial hardship to cover these costs when things go wrong.

Travellers without travel insurance are personally liable for covering any medical and associated costs they incur.

On Tour

ARRIVAL AT SYDNEY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Please meet at the COUNTER B area at 11:30am and then stay with the group ALL the way through the airport. Please ensure you have your passports on hand. It's a good idea to make sure you have this ready before you leave home.

Everyone should wear comfortable, *loose fitting clothing* for travel. For people that have medical conditions relating to their circulation or blood, please ask your doctor whether medical compression tights should be worn while flying.

Please note- If you are not at the airport to meet us and miss the first flight, the airline automatically cancels your return flight. Allow extra time to ensure you are there!

CUSTOMS & IMMIGRATION

When meeting at all security gates and departure lounges your Tour Leaders will inform you of the relevant forms that need to be completed when boarding the plane and during arrival procedures. Some of the forms you may need to complete include an arrival card and a customs declaration card. You will need to have your passport available for immigration and customs officers. Please be aware that customs procedures are very strict. You must declare any food items, animal products and wooden/plant products. Penalties also apply for exceeding duty free limits.

DOCUMENTATION & MEDICATION

Don't pack your travel documents and passport in your luggage, rather take it with you in your carry on bag. Remember to pack more than enough of any medication you might need and ensure that any prescription medication has your name printed on it by the Pharmacy.

IN FLIGHT

The airlines give us a big block of seats. You will be allocated a seat within this group. Seat assignment is done by the airline, not by Travel Gang.

Use lip balm frequently and re-hydrate often with water. Cover yourself with a warm blanket or sweater when sleeping. Walk around and complete in-seat stretches often. Force yourself to sleep otherwise you may be disorientated over the next 2 days.

BUDDY SYSTEM

It is expected that all tour members (students and chaperones) be in the company of another tour member at all times. With particular concern to public places such as museums, toilets, shopping centres, airports to name a few.

HOTEL BEHAVIOUR

- Always be aware of individual hotel rules posted in each room.
- Students are not permitted to leave the confines of the hotel without their chaperone.
- Make note of the room numbers of the Tour Leaders at each hotel.
- Tour members are not to change rooms.
- Number of persons per room is dictated by hotel policy.
- Do not congregate/hang out in hotel corridors.
- Students are not permitted to invite any non-tour members to their room.
- Students are not to leave their room after the advised curfew time.
- Always secure luggage and valuables safely when not in your room.
- Punctuality at meeting times and meeting points is imperative in order to make transfers and flights. Return your key on check out.
- Travel Gang will not under any circumstances be responsible for hotel expenses (room service, in-house movies, laundry etc.) incurred by any tour member.
- In-house hotel expenses must be paid for well before check-out in order to meet transfers/flights etc. it is recommended you do this the night before check-out.

IF YOU ARE LOST

In the event you become separated from the main group please follow these steps:

- 1. Contact the Tour Leader immediately via WhatsApp or Facebook Messenger.
- 2. Try and contact another tour member.
- 3. Make your way to the assigned meeting point/area and wait for the group to return.
- 4. Call the hotel and give your whereabouts.
- 5. Ask staff at a nearby shop, restaurant, café etc. for assistance and ask them to contact your hotel.

DO NOT: Wait on the street; accept a lift from anyone or catch a taxi cab without a chaperone.

SAFETY AND WELFARE

Tour member's safety is of the utmost importance to Travel Gang. See below advice and tips about safety and welfare whilst on tour:

- Stay with your group at all times.
- Be sure to always confirm the arranged meeting times and meeting points.
- Do not make it obvious that you are carrying money, credit cards and other valuables.
- Any individual who places themselves, other tour members, or the tour at risk will be excluded from continuing the tour at the sole discretion of Travel Gang.
- Always carry some form of identification.
- Always carry your phone so you can contact the Tour Leaders if needed.
- Always be ON TIME. If you are late, the group will leave and a (unhappy) chaperone
 will have to wait behind for you. Students who are late may be disciplined by the
 teachers. This could involve missing out on fun tour activities.
- Always carry a small amount of cash. Some places (especially markets) are cash only.
- Respect the laws of the county we are visiting. Drug activity, shop lifting, physical violence, vandalism, and verbal abuse are illegal.
- Cross roads only at traffic lights.

If you are unsure about anything or anyone always talk with your Tour Leaders.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Travel Gang code of conduct is outlined in the "Terms and Conditions" that you agreed to upon application for this tour. Please refer to this for specific details and policies. Throughout the tour it is a Travel Gang policy for all tour members to strive to promote harmony and good will. Travelling as a group, as opposed to travelling independently, carries with it not just responsibility for yourself but for all other members of your group. Here are our top 4 things to keep in mind:

- 1. Treat all tour members respectfully and courteously.
- 2. Value other tour member's personal property and need for privacy and personal space.
- 3. Bullying and harassment within the tour in any form will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- 4. All Travel Gang adventures are drug free for all travellers.

MOBILE PHONE USE

Ensure that you have arranged for global roaming (including data) switched on for your device. This typically comes at a cost of \$10 per day depending on your phone plan. It also provides data with a limit so take care to monitor your data usage. It is better to share photos and videos when using the hotel WiFi.

KEEP CALM

We are all going to have so much fun on this tour. If you're a regular traveller, you will know that sometimes plans need to change for many reasons. You are being looked after by the awesome Travel Gang tour guides so there will be nothing to worry about. Just go with the flow and let us solve any issues that pop up along the way. Your flexibility is appreciated.

When you are travelling so close to people for such a long time, there will be times when you just want your own space. If that happens to you, we recommend you put your earphones in and listen to some music for a while. If you see someone else having some 'earphone time', give them a few moments to themselves unless your message is truly important.

SPENDING MONEY

Please budget your money carefully to ensure that you have enough for meals throughout the trip. Around \$50 GBP/EURO per day should be budgeted for your meals and snacks.

While it is not recommended for anyone to carry large amounts of cash, avoid letting yourself fall short of money as ATMs are often difficult to locate. We strongly advise against using credit cards when buying from small street merchants. Please note that each participant is responsible for managing their own money while on tour.

LOOKING AFTER YOUR THINGS

Tour participants are responsible for looking after their own belongings while on tour. It is not possible for us to return to a tour venue so take care not to leave items (like phones/cameras) behind.

MEALS IN FLIGHT

If you indicated that you have dietary requirements, we have emailed you with special meal options to choose from. As ask that you reply to that email with your special meal request no later than June 20.

NOTE: Airlines are notoriously bad at catering for dietary requests. We advise you check with the flight attendant that your meal is appropriate for your dietary requirements. We recommend you bring snacks as a back-up to ensure you don't go hungry.

DOCTORS

In case of sickness, advise one of the Travel Gang staff, who can then take you to a doctor or the hospital. You will be responsible for paying the doctor and making any claims back via your travel insurance if it is an eligible claim for the policy you purchased.

PHARMACIES


If you require any medication while you are away, even basic headache or pain relief, please advise one of the Travel Gang staff and we will support you to get what you need.

ROOM CHARGES

Please take care not to charge anything to your room at any of the hotels. This includes restaurant service, room service, movies etc. In order to speed up the check-in process, we use the Travel Gang credit card against all rooms. If you do charge to the room, you will need to reimburse Travel Gang.

Note: If Travel Gang is charged for any room incidentals, we will charge you an additional admin fee when we recoup the money from you. Please avoid this.
