The recipient will engage in masterclasses, attend Broadway shows and interact with industry professionals.

This transformative experience will have a lasting impact on the recipient's career and benefit the students and communities they serve.

- The scholarship is open to performing arts educators, including teachers, directors, choreographers, music directors and drama tutors, currently working in Australia or New Zealand.
- The applicant must have been actively involved in their school, academy, or studio for at least three consecutive years and be over 21 years of age.

- Applicants must hold a valid Australian or New Zealand passport, or be willing to arrange one if offered a place on the adventure.
- Applicants must hold a valid working with children check.

- The scholarship is non-transferable and cannot be postponed, redeemed for cash, or exchanged for any form of credit.


Selection and Notification
